Drake's remains Surrey's only Michelin starred restaurant, an accolade which it has now held for six consecutive years. The quality of food is, of course, excellent and service is friendly and unobtrusive, welcoming rather than stand-offish. Prices reflect the quality you would expect and set lunch menus offer good value if your working day permits. Located slightly further away from The Manor House than some of our other suggestions (about a 20 minute drive) but definitely worth the journey.
